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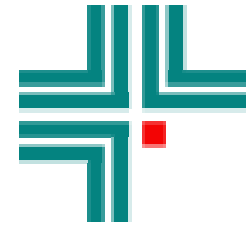

NEPHROLOGY FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The Nephrology Fellowship at Jacobi Medical Center is a two-year program. The first year comprises of clinical rotations on the inpatient consult service at Jacobi Medical Center and North Central Bronx Hospital. The second year is divided between research, transplant and electives.

The large volume and broad range of patients seen at Jacobi Medical Center and North Central Bronx hospitals ensures a great clinical experience. This, along with the new state-of-the-art facility will make it an outstanding experience. The fellows will cover both Jacobi Medical Center and North Central Bronx Hospital and the Pelham Parkway outpatient dialysis unit.

There are presently 4 full-time and 2 part-time faculty members in the Nephrology Division. A combination of lectures, hands-on learning environment, supervised autonomy and a wide range of patients will make for an invaluable opportunity to learn Nephrology.

FELLOWSHIP GOALS

The goal of the fellowship is to provide outstanding training. The fellows will receive training in all aspects of Nephrology, including Acute and Chronic Dialysis, CRRT, Renal

Biopsies and Clinical Nephrology comprising of Inpatient Consults and Outpatient Renal Clinics. All this will be provided in a nurturing academic environment.

The fellowship program is also affiliated with Columbia Presbyterian Medical Center for Renal Pathology and Transplant Surgery.

ROTATIONS

FIRST YEAR

Jacobi Medical Center inpatient and dialysis consults

North Central Bronx Hospital inpatient and dialysis consults.

SECOND YEAR

Research - Clinical or Basic Science
2 blocks each of two weeks elective time.
Electives available at this time include Urology, Renal Pathology at Columbia Presbyterian, Vascular Surgery or Interventional Radiology.
2 blocks JMC/NCB Inpatient consult service
Renal Transplant at Columbia Presbyterian Medical Center.

Each fellow will have a renal continuity clinic either at Jacobi Medical Center or North Central Bronx Hospital.

Out Patient Hemodialysis Unit rotation in the second year.

In addition, there will be a combined Renal/Urology Stone clinic.
